

## Your Help is Urgently Needed!

**Who?** Anyone turning 12 or older this year. Those under 16 should always be assigned to work with their parent or an assigned adult guardian.

**What?** Removing water, mud, and drywall from 1,000 to 3,000 flooded homes in the greater Dearborn/Detroit area.

**When?** Friday, Saturday, and Sunday, July 2, 3, and 4.

**Time?** You can arrive at any time between 8:00 a.m. and 4:00 p.m. each day.

**Where?** Please go to the Dearborn ward building, located at 20201 Rotunda, Dearborn, MI 48124. There you will receive an assignment regarding where to go to assist in the cleanup.

**How does it work?** Upon arrival, you (and anyone traveling with you) will be assigned to a team of up to 10 people and will be given 2-3 houses to rescue.

**What should I bring?** If you can, please bring any of the following items that you have:

- Gloves – highly recommended
- Boots to be worn while working the in water and mud.
- Hammers and/or crowbars to assist in removing drywall.
- Sharp knives or razor type box cutters to cut through drywall.
- Bottles of water to keep hydrated.
- Snacks to maintain energy.
- Long pants to wear while working in the homes (this will protect your legs from cuts and scratches.)
- 5-gallon buckets
- Shovels
- Rakes
- Wheelbarrows
